

Appleford School, Salisbury

Client – Appleford School, Shrewton, Nr Salisbury

Scope of Works

Construction of two storey multipurpose accommodation block with 5 classrooms including Home Economics Classroom, new Toilet facilities, plant room and circulation area to ground floor, and bedrooms with en-suite facilities, kitchen, living and common rooms, and sick bay to first floor and 3no Parking spaces externally.

It was built using traditional masonry construction with concrete floors but with external render and timber cladding to complement the backdrop of a wooded area of the school site in which the new building is situated. A grey slate roof sets off the cladding.

Internally the bedrooms have adjoining shower suites with some catering for DDA requirements and a passenger lift is provided for first floor access. A common room is included together with a live in flat for the staff.

This was a sloped site requiring retaining walls and stepped foundations.

The project was completed in 32 weeks and the client commented that despite a small number of variations it met his own programme and budget.
